League Meeting Minutes, 28 October 2003 at 8:30pm, Terrace Community Building.



OLD ISSUES :

Dates were determined for Post Season Games for 2004. The Super Bowls will be scheduled for October 31 at Mitchell Field, Pee-Wee Game will start at 3:00pm, followed by the Midget Game at 6:00pm. The Senior Bowl will also be held at Mitchell Field on November 7 starting at 1:30pm, followed by the Punt, Pass & Kick at 4:30pm.

Weight and scales has been a big issue over the last few years. A vote was taken in favor for a 3 x 3 plywood base be furnished by the League, with a 25lb weight plate. All scales will be placed on the plywood on a solid area and the 25lb plate will be used for the calibration of the scales.

All weights will be recorded on the Cover Rosters when turned, these weights will also be recorded at the Centralized Signup's.
