League Meeting Minutes, 9 August 2004 at 8:00pm, Terrace Community Building



OLD ISSUES :

Rosters were collected for the 2004 season, no longer will teams be able to sign-up any players for this season.

Mark Feltman of East Juniata stated there is a strong possibility for a Flag Football team in that area for the 2004 season. 6 players are currently signed.

Schedule was finalized with Darren Curry. Any further changes through out the season, please contact him and the League Secretary with the changes.

A reminder for the JVFL weight limits, Pee-Wee players will not exceed the weight of 110 lbs to participate, and Midgets will be 140 lbs. No exceptions will be made, that is the limit.

To scrimmage a team outside the JVFL, you will need prior approval from a Officer, given a 2 week notice, and the participating JVFL team will be responsible for the Insurance Rider to ensure coverage.

Cheerleading Competition's regulations have been revised by a unanimous decision by the League, and will be placed in the Rules and Regulations as Follows : " It is the stand of the JVFL that it is an Organization decision as to whether or not Cheer Squads attend Competitions. The JVFL will provide liability insurance for these Competitions provided we are notified in advance (2 weeks), that a squad will be attending and that all JVFL By-Law's are followed. This means, there will be no cutting of Competition Squads, age guidelines must be followed and certain maneuver's banned by our insurance clause cannot be used. All funding, with the exception of the insurance rider, will also be the responsibility of the participating Organization."

Heat Acclamation Period for the JVFL was discussed, this will be determined after the 2004 season in preparation for the 2005 season.

There will be no Divisions for the League for 2004, standings will run 1st through 11th. A Regular Season Champion will be given an award at the end of the season for both Pee-Wee and Midget Divisions. (Same as last year)
